CAMP LEADERSHIP

Elisa Hennies, Youth Development Director, heads the Lake County Central Y Day Camp. Better known as Miss E, she has been a part of Lake County Y Day Camp for over a decade, this summer being her 17th year!

Our leadership staff have many years of experience directing YMCA camping programs to literally thousands of children. Counselors are chosen for their maturity, desire and ability to be good role models for campers, educational background and ability to interact with and create a fun environment for kids. Our camp staff are background checked and trained in CPR, First-Aid, behavior and conflict management, risk management, leadership, and thorough emergency procedures.

A ONE-OF-A-KIND OUTDOOR Y

Day campers can look forward to visiting the Outdoor Y in Perry all summer. The Outdoor Y has a large Family Aquatic Center with an Olympic size pool, spiral water slide, and a drop slide along with two aqua climbing walls. The Family Aquatic Center also has an interactive spray-n-play area including a double dump bucket that gradually fills itself and then spills, a rain castle, a rain hoop that produces a rainbow-like shimmer of water, circle jets, and rain tunnel with jets of water coming from the concrete pad at such an angle that they "sculpt" a tunnel.

On the rest of its 177 acres, the Outdoor Y has a gaga pit, basketball court, tennis court, volleyball court, playground, athletic fields, and scenic wooded trails leading down to the Grand River.

OPEN HOUSE

We will have 2 options for orientation this summer. **All new campers and parents should attend!** One will be Wednesday, May 28 at 6pm at the Central Y in Painesville and the other Saturday, May 31 at 10am at the Outdoor Y in Perry. Past campers are also welcome to come meet staff and pick up camp shirts.

REFUND POLICY

A \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is required at the time of registration per child per week. The balance of fees is due on the Friday before each week of camp. A \$10 late fee will be incurred for any payment made after that.

*Cancellation Refund Allowances:

- 14 days or more prior to the scheduled camp week = full refund minus the \$25 deposit for that week
- 4-13 days prior to scheduled camp week = Y account credit minus the \$25 deposit for that week
- The weekend prior to scheduled camp week (Fri-Sun) = forfeit of all fees paid.
- If you do not notify us of cancellation, and your child does not attend camp, you will still be charged the full amount for the week. **Help us allow a camper from the waitlist to enjoy a week of camp by cancelling in a timely manner.**

The Lake County Y camps reserve the right to issue credits in lieu of refunds in the unlikely event of an act of God, war, terrorism, civil unrest, communicable disease or any other non-personal situation that, in the camp's sole judgement, could lead to significant cancellations that would have a negative financial impact on the future of camp.

CAMP SCHEDULE

Hours 9 am - 4 pm

Drop off between 8:30 -8:55 am

The bus leaves promptly at 9 am daily.

Pick up between 4 - 4:30 pm

(Campers picked up after 4:30 pm will automatically be enrolled in extended care for the week.)

Check in/out takes place in the rear parking lot, located in the back of the Central Y. Photo ID may be required. Refer to the weekly schedule.

Additional child \$165/week (Members ONLY)

There is a \$10 late fee for any payment made after the due date. Please assist us by submitting payments on time.

CAMPDOC

In continuous efforts to provide the best possible care to our campers, Lake County Central Day Camp is partnering with CampDoc.com. CampDoc.com is an electronic health record system for camps and will help us consolidate and integrate camper health information into a centralized and secure location. Their system will give our camp director instant access to camper health information, have quick digital access and assist in providing quality care for your camper.

The security, confidentiality and privacy of your camper's personal health information will always be protected. Only designated camp staff will have access to this information.

After you register for camp, watch your email for a welcome letter from CampDoc that will have a link for you to set up your account and begin to file your forms electronically! No more paper!! All forms must be on file PRIOR to your child's first day of camp.
