A ONE-OF-A-KIND OUTDOOR Y

In addition to the great facilities at the East End Y, day campers can also look forward to visiting the Outdoor Y in Perry. The Outdoor Y has a large Family Aquatic Center with an Olympic size pool, spiral water slide, and a drop slide along with two aqua climbing walls. The Family Aquatic Center also has an interactive spray-n-play area including a double dump bucket that gradually fills itself and then spills, a rain castle, a rain hoop that produces a rainbow-like shimmer of water, circle jets, and rain tunnel with jets of water coming from the concrete pad at such an angle that they "sculpt" a tunnel.

On the rest of its 177 acres, the Outdoor Y has a gaga pit, basketball court, tennis court, playground, athletic fields, music playground, obstacle course, hammock village, and scenic wooded trails leading down to the Grand River.

PREPARE FOR FUN

Our Day Camp offers a wide array of activities including field trips, swimming, arts and crafts, games, sports, nature activities, special events, songs, skits and more. Even rainy days are fun! Many of our activities include getting wet, dirty and very messy! Please make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothes to take part in such activities.



OPEN HOUSE

We will be having an open house for parents. Information will be sent out at a later date. **All new campers and parents should attend!** Past campers are also welcome to come meet staff and pick up camp shirts.

REFUND POLICY

A \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is required at the time of registration per child per week. The balance of fees is due on the Friday before each week of camp. A \$10 late fee will be incurred for any payment made after that.

*Cancellation Refund Allowances:

- 14 days or more prior to the scheduled camp week = full refund minus the \$25 deposit for that week
- 4-13 days prior to scheduled camp week = Y account credit minus the \$25 deposit for that week
- The weekend prior to scheduled camp week (Fri-Sun) = forfeit of all fees paid.
- If you do not notify us of cancellation, and your child does not attend camp, you will still be charged the full amount for the week. **Help us allow a camper from the waitlist to enjoy a week of camp by cancelling in a timely manner.**

The Lake County Y camps reserve the right to issue credits in lieu of refunds in the unlikely event of an act of God, war, terrorism, civil unrest, communicable disease or any other non-personal situation that, in the camp's sole judgement, could lead to significant cancellations that would have a negative financial impact on the future of camp.

REGISTRATION

PROGRAM FEE ASSISTANCE Deadline May 1, 2026

We believe that financial hardship should not prevent children from attending Summer Camp and because of the generosity of donors, we are able to offer financial assistance. Applications available online and at the Y.

2026 FEES

A \$25 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is required at the time of registration per child per week. The balance of fees is due on the Friday before each week of camp. **MUST be an active member at time of registration to receive member rate and remain an active member through the end of all registered camp weeks.**

First Addition Child: \$175/week
Second Addition Child: \$170/week

A \$5 late fee is assessed for every 5 min after the 6 pm pick-up time.

CAMPER AGE GROUPS

Pioneers

Entering Grades 1 & 2
