RENTALS

GROUP RENTAL

Book your exclusive party at the pool which includes the use of the pavilion. Grill out, swim and have fun. The cost for up to 30 participants is \$350, each additional participant is \$10 . Non-refundable deposit of \$50 (2 hour rental). Deposit must be paid at the time of the booking. Larger groups please call for pricing. Parties available Fridays and Saturdays from 6:30–8:30pm, Sundays from 6–8pm. Payment must be paid two weeks prior to the rental. If you want other days/times, please call.

PAVILION RENTAL

Reserve the outside pavilion for exclusive use during Houston–Fisher hours. Cost \$50. No pool passes are included in the reservation. If Houston–Fisher is closed, bathrooms will not be available for use.

SAFE POOLS HAVE RULES

Welcome to the Pool! Our pool rules help ensure a safe experience so everyone can have fun and enjoy the pool.

Age Guidelines

Ages 5 & under: Adult must be in the water within arm's reach of child at all times

Ages 6-9: Must be accompanied by an Adult IN the pool. After passing swim test, an adult must remain in the pool area

Ages 10-13: Allowed only in the shallow water until swim test is passed

Children under 10 must be accompanied by parent/guardian in the facility

Children 13 and under must pass the deep water test in order to swim in the deep end

PARENTS/GUARDIAN ARE ULTIMATELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF THEIR CHILD

Swim diapers are required for any child who is NOT toilet trained

Parent/Guardian must be no more than an arms length away from their child

Only US Coast Guard approved flotation devices allowed

Lifejackets are not permitted in the 12' end of the pool

Proper swim attire is required

The last 15 minutes of each hour is open swim time for adults 18 years and older, except the closing hour

The following are not permitted:

- Extended breath holding activities
- Diving in the shallow areas of the pool
- Glass containers
- Inflatable devices
- Smoking and alcohol are strictly prohibited
- Profanity will not be tolerated

Please be respectful of others

Lake County YMCA lifeguards and management reserve the right to modify the rules as necessary.
